- Project Management has not significantly changed in over 60 years

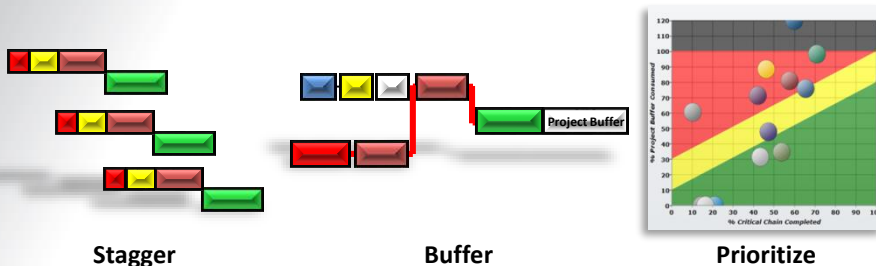
Critical Chain Project Management ensures that...
